# HP's tips for climate bliss

## Make smart purchasing decisions

Buy ENERGY STAR® or other energy efficiency rated **eco-labeled** computers and peripherals. They can help you save energy and money.

Consider using **flat-panel** liquid crystal display (LCD) monitors versus conventional CRT monitors. LCD monitors reduce energy consumption by a third.

Choose **multi-function devices** – such as HP All-in-Ones – that save energy compared to several products working in parallel.

Select printers or multi-function products that offer **two-sided printing** to reduce paper and energy usage.

When upgrading to more energy-efficient products, check out HP's **trade-in** and **recycling** options for your used computer or printing hardware, batteries and HP printing supplies: [hp.com/eur/returnandrecycle](http://hp.com/eur/returnandrecycle)

## Conserve resources during use

Enable the **energy saving settings** on PCs and peripherals in the power-options menu in your PC's control panel.

**Disable your screen savers** to reduce energy use. A monitor in screen-saving mode uses significantly more energy than one in standby mode.

Set **printers to sleep mode**. The printer will quickly return to "activity" status when new print jobs are submitted.
